- Monthly Tuition \$118 (9 months of tutions with classes Sept. through mid May)
- Dancers learn Pom, Jazz, Hip Hop, and Kick/Acro routines as well as focus on technique, teamwork, leadership, and responsibility.
- Acro Dance is incorporated into the Silver team instruction so that these dancers can learn the basics of Acro Dance and how it benefits all styles of dance.

SUMMER OPTIONS FOR PLATINUM & SILVER

- Below are optional, but suggested programs for dancers in the summer.
- Dancers that are 5th-7th grade are eligible to audition for the Sapphire team. The Sapphire team is an intensive program that helps dancers progress quickly in a short amount of time. See details under Sapphire team description.
- Dancers that are 1st- 4th grade are recommended to take the Pom & Jazz combo, 6 week session to continue building their technique, memorization skills, and get the sense of how a competition team would run throughout the winter season. This class follows the two night per week format like school season does and will move at a quicker pace with learning routines. The Pom & Jazz combo class, which serves as competition prep is recommended but not required. If the Pom & Jazz combo class does not work for your schedule, we encourage Hip Hop or Acro Dance from the 6 week summer sessions which meets one night per week and/or the Pom baseball camp week.
